Attention mobile food truck owners, this document is intended to provide direction for the inspection requirements for operating mobile food trucks within the West Oakland County Mutual Aid Association.

- **There are twelve (12) departments that are participating in the food truck inspection program; The City of Farmington, Walled Lake, Novi, City of Northville, South Lyon, Milford, Wixom, Lyon Township, White Lake, Highland, Brighton, and West Bloomfield.**
- **How the program works:**
 1. **Contact one of the participating fire departments to schedule your inspection. The inspection shall be scheduled a minimum of 72 hours before your event.**
 2. **Once your food truck passes the inspection, you will receive a West Oakland County Mutual Aid Association Annual Food Truck Inspection Program sticker, valid for one year from the inspection date.**
 3. **Your food truck inspection sticker will be accepted by all twelve (12) of the participating departments.**
 4. **Participating fire departments reserve the right to do a spot check inspection for food trucks on location. You are not required to schedule these inspections.**

The goal of the West Oakland County Mutual Aid Association is to stream line the process for food truck vendors as well as the participating fire departments regarding food truck inspections. This program will eliminate redundancy of conducting multiple inspections by the participating departments and provide consistency in conducting food truck inspections.
